## A BILL ENTITLED

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Water Quality Financing Administration

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 (a) Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, in this subtitle the 22 following words have the meanings indicated.

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1 (b) "Administration" means the Maryland Water Quality Financing 2 Administration.

3 (c) "Bay Restoration Fund" means the Bay Restoration Fund established 4 under § 9–1605.2 of this subtitle.

 $\mathbf{5}$ "Wastewater facility" means any equipment, plant, treatment works, (ii) 6 structure, machinery, apparatus, interest in land, or any combination of these, which 7is acquired, used, constructed, or operated for the storage, collection, treatment, 8 neutralization, stabilization, reduction, recycling, reclamation, separation, or disposal 9 of wastewater, or for the final disposal of residues resulting from the treatment of 10 wastewater, including: treatment or disposal plants; outfall sewers, interceptor 11 sewers, and collector sewers; pumping and ventilating stations, facilities, and works; 12programs and projects for controlling nonpoint sources of water pollution and for estuarine conservation and management; and other real or personal property and 1314appurtenances incident to their development, use, or operation.

(jj) "Water Quality Fund" means the Maryland Water Quality RevolvingLoan Fund.

18 (A) In addition to the powers set forth elsewhere in this subtitle, but subject 19 to such rules or program directives as the Secretary may from time to time prescribe, 20 the Administration may:

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(1) Adopt and alter an official seal;

22 (2) Sue and be sued, plead, and be impleaded;

23 (3) Adopt bylaws, rules, and regulations to carry out the provisions of24 this subtitle;

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(4) Maintain an office at such place as the Secretary may designate;

1 Enter into contracts of any kind, and execute all instruments (8) $\mathbf{2}$ necessary or convenient with respect to carrying out the powers in this subtitle to accomplish the purposes of the Administration; 3 4 (9)Make loans, enter into loan agreements, and accept and enforce loan obligations:  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 Award grants, enter into grant agreements, and accept and enforce (10)7grant obligations; 8 (11)Subject to the prior approval of the Board and the Secretary, issue bonds under this subtitle; and 9 10 Do all acts and things necessary or convenient to carry out the (12)11 powers granted by this subtitle. 12**(B)** (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE 13**PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION UNDER: (I)** THE WATER QUALITY FUND; 1415**(II)** THE BAY RESTORATION FUND; 16 THE BIOLOGICAL NUTRIENT REMOVAL PROGRAM; AND (III) THE SUPPLEMENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. 17(IV) 18THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ENSURE THE FAIR AND (2) EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AMONG WASTEWATER 1920TREATMENT FACILITIES WITH A DESIGN CAPACITY OF LESS THAN 500.000 21GALLONS PER DAY AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES WITH A DESIGN 22CAPACITY OF 500,000 GALLONS OR MORE PER DAY. 23SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24July 1, 2014.

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
