11 workers' compensation law.

13 Chapter 98 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2008
14 Section 2

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Chapter 98 of the Acts of 2008**

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
