# 2 Maryland Horse Racing Act – Sunset Extension and Program Evaluation

FOR the purpose of extending the date on which the Maryland Horse Racing Act
terminates; requiring that an evaluation in accordance with the Maryland
Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) be made of the State Racing Commission,
the Maryland-Bred Race Fund Advisory Committee, and the Maryland
Standardbred Race Fund Advisory Committee and the related statutes and
regulations on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the Maryland
Horse Racing Act.
