## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Refillable Containers

3 FOR the purpose of creating in Harford County a refillable container permit; 4 authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the permit to a holder 5 of a Class A-1 or A-2 alcoholic beverages license, to certain holders of Class B 6 alcoholic beverages licenses, or to a holder of a Class D alcoholic beverages 7 license; specifying that a holder of the permit may sell draft beer for 8 consumption off the licensed premises in a certain refillable container; requiring 9 a refillable container to meet certain requirements; prohibiting a holder of the permit from affixing certain corrective labels or warnings to a refillable 10 container; allowing a holder of a permit to refill only certain refillable 11 12containers; requiring a holder of a permit to seal the refillable container at the 13 time of each refill; providing for a certain annual fee for the permit; specifying the term of and hours of sale for the permit; authorizing the Board to adopt 14 certain regulations; and generally relating to the establishment of a refillable 15 16 container permit in Harford County.

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 23

MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN HARFORD COUNTY. 1 (A) 2 **(B)** THERE IS A REFILLABLE CONTAINER PERMIT. 3 THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A REFILLABLE CONTAINER PERMIT TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS A-1 OR A-2 LICENSE, A CLASS B LICENSE THAT HAS 4 5 OFF-SALE PRIVILEGES, OR A CLASS D LICENSE. 6 SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, A REFILLABLE 7 CONTAINER PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO SELL DRAFT BEER FOR CONSUMPTION OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES IN A REFILLABLE CONTAINER 8 9 WITH A CAPACITY OF NOT LESS THAN 32 OUNCES AND NOT MORE THAN 128 10 OUNCES. 11 **(E)** TO BE USED AS A REFILLABLE CONTAINER UNDER SUBSECTION (D) 12 OF THIS SECTION, A CONTAINER SHALL: 13 **(1)** BE SEALABLE; 14 BE BRANDED WITH AN IDENTIFYING MARK OF THE PERMIT 15 HOLDER WHO SELLS THE CONTAINER; 16 **(3)** BEAR THE FEDERAL HEALTH WARNING **STATEMENT** 17 REQUIRED FOR CONTAINERS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES UNDER 27 C.F.R. 16.21; 18 19 **(4)** DISPLAY INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING THE CONTAINER; AND 20**(5)** BEAR A LABEL STATING THAT: 21(I)CLEANING THE CONTAINER IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF 22 THE CONSUMER; AND 23THE CONTENTS OF THE CONTAINER ARE PERISHABLE 24AND SHOULD BE REFRIGERATED IMMEDIATELY AND CONSUMED WITHIN 48
- 26 (F) (1) ALL LABELS AND WARNINGS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION 27 (E) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE PREPRINTED ON THE REFILLABLE CONTAINER.
- 28 (2) A HOLDER OF A REFILLABLE CONTAINER PERMIT MAY NOT 29 AFFIX A CORRECTIVE LABEL OR WARNING TO THE REFILLABLE CONTAINER.

- 2 (1) MAY REFILL ONLY A REFILLABLE CONTAINER THAT WAS 3 BRANDED BY A REFILLABLE CONTAINER PERMIT HOLDER IN THE COUNTY; AND
- 4 (2) SHALL SEAL THE REFILLABLE CONTAINER AT THE TIME OF 5 EACH REFILL.
- 6 (H) THE ANNUAL PERMIT FEE IS \$50.
- 7 (I) THE TERM OF AND THE HOURS OF SALE FOR A REFILLABLE 8 CONTAINER PERMIT ARE THE SAME AS THOSE FOR THE UNDERLYING LICENSE.
- 9 (J) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 10 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
