# State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors – Funeral Establishments – Unannounced Inspections

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain inspections of licensed funeral establishments  $\mathbf{5}$ to include, under certain circumstances, advance notice that an inspector may 6 be in a certain region for a certain purpose; <del>requiring a certain licensee or an</del> 7 employee of the licensee to give certain access to certain members or employees of the State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors for the purpose of 8 9 conducting certain inspections of certain funeral establishments, including 10 access to certain areas of the funeral establishments; authorizing certain staff 11 members of the State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors to call certain supervising morticians and request certain access to certain areas of a funeral 12 13establishment under certain circumstances; requiring certain supervising morticians to immediately provide certain staff members with the location of 14 the key or access code to certain areas of a funeral establishment; providing that 15certain employees are not required to accompany certain staff while the staff 16 conducts certain inspections; requiring certain inspections to be conducted 17during certain hours: providing for the application of certain provisions of this 18 19Act; requiring the Board to provide the results of certain inspections to certain 20licensees or supervising morticians within a certain period of time; and 21generally relating to the inspection of funeral establishments by the State 22Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors.
