- 3 (B) TO ADVANCE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT EFFORTS, THE BOARD SHALL PROVIDE TO RESIDENTS AND COMMUNITY LEADERS IN EACH NEIGHBORHOOD OR GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION THAT SURROUNDS A PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY THAT IS IDENTIFIED FOR REPLACEMENT, RENOVATION, OR CLOSURE IN THE BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOLS' 10–YEAR PLAN:
