- 17 (f) (1) A county or municipality shall establish policies and procedures, 18 approved by the Department, to reduce [any portion of] a stormwater remediation fee
- 19 established under subsection (e) of this section FOR BOTH RESIDENTIAL AND
- NONRESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OWNERS to account for on-site and off-site systems, facilities, services, or activities that reduce the quantity or improve the quality of
