## AN ACT concerning

## All-Terrain Vehicles - Protective Equipment

FOR the purpose of prohibiting an individual from operating or riding on an all-terrain vehicle unless the individual is wearing protective headgear and an eye-protective device that meet certain standards; defining a certain term; and generally relating to required equipment for individuals operating or riding on all-terrain vehicles.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

## 21-1207.3.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTORIZED VEHICLE THAT:
(1) IS DESIGNED TO TRAVEL OFF-HIGHWAY;
(2) IS DESIGNED TO TRAVEL ON THREE OR FOUR LOW-PRESSURE TIRES;
(3) HAS A SEAT DESIGNED TO BE STRADDLED BY THE OPERATOR;

(4) HAS HANDLEBARS FOR STEERING CONTROL; AND
(5) IS INTENDED BY THE MANUFACTURER FOR USE BY A SINGLE OPERATOR OR AN OPERATOR AND ONE PASSENGER.
(B) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT OPERATE OR RIDE ON AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL IS WEARING PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR AND AN EYE-PROTECTIVE DEVICE THAT MEET THE STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE Administrator for motorcycle helmets and eye-protective devices UNDER § 21-1306 OF THIS TITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
