21 22	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 1 (a) (2) As to all or any part of any transportation facilities project, the 2 Authority may:
- 3 (i) Fix, revise, charge, and collect rentals, rates, fees, tolls, and 4 other charges and revenues for its use or for its services; and
- 5 (ii) Contract with any person who desires its use for any 6 purpose and fix the terms, conditions, rentals, rates, fees, tolls, or other charges or 7 revenues for this use.
- 8 (c) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the rentals, rates, fees, tolls, and other charges and revenues are not subject to supervision or regulation by any instrumentality, agency, or unit of this State or any of its political subdivisions.
- 11 (2) This subtitle does not permit the exercise of any power or the 12 undertaking of any activity that would conflict with the provisions and limitations of 13 the federal Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964.
- 14 (3) Tolls for the use of the bridge carrying the John F. Kennedy 15 Memorial Highway over the Susquehanna River may not be less than the comparable 16 tolls charged for the use of the Susquehanna River Bridge.
- 17 (4) (I) IN THIS PARAGRAPH, "E-ZPASS DISCOUNT PLAN"
  18 MEANS A TOLL PREPAYMENT OPTION UNDER WHICH AN E-ZPASS ACCOUNT
  19 HOLDER PAYS FOR THE RIGHT TO USE A PARTICULAR TRANSPORTATION
  20 FACILITIES PROJECT A SPECIFIED NUMBER OF TIMES DURING A SPECIFIED
  21 PERIOD AT A COST PER USE THAT IS LESS THAN THE TOLL THAT IS USUALLY
  22 CHARGED FOR USE OF THE TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES PROJECT.
- (II) AN E-ZPASS DISCOUNT PLAN SHALL ALLOW AN ACCOUNT HOLDER TO UTILIZE THE FULL VALUE OF THE PLAN BY TAKING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF TRIPS ALLOWED UNDER THE PLAN OVER AN UNLIMITED PERIOD OF TIME.
- 27 (III) THE AUTHORITY MAY NOT INCREASE THE COST OF AN 28 E-ZPASS DISCOUNT PLAN IN RESPONSE TO THE REQUIREMENT OF THIS 29 PARAGRAPH.
- [(4)](5) Prior to fixing or revising tolls on any part of any transportation facilities project, the Authority shall provide, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee, Senate Finance Committee, House Appropriations Committee, and House Ways and Means Committee information on the proposed toll charges, including:
  - (i) The annual revenues generated by the toll charges;

2	(i	ii)	The proposed commuter discount rates.
