A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Business Regulation – Retail Service Stations – Video Cameras Required**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring each retail service station dealer to maintain at least
4 one operational video camera on the exterior of the premises of the service
5 station for a certain purpose; requiring each retail service station dealer to
6 preserve recordings made by the video camera for at least a certain period of
7 time; requiring the video camera to be capable of recording a certain image for a
8 certain purpose; establishing a penalty for a violation of this Act; providing for a
9 delayed effective date; and generally relating to video cameras at retail service
10 stations.
