1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Environment – Cox Creek Citizens Oversight Committee – Composition**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the composition of the Cox Creek Citizens Oversight
4 Committee to reflect changes made to the State's legislative districts; and
5 generally relating to the Cox Creek Citizens Oversight Committee.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Environment**

14 5–1102.1.

15 (a) (1) The Governor shall appoint a Cox Creek Citizens Oversight
16 Committee.

17 (2) The terms of the members of the Oversight Committee shall be
18 determined by the Governor.

1 (b) The Oversight Committee shall be composed of the following members:

2 (1) 2 members of the North County Land Trust;

3 (2) 1 delegate to the Greater Pasadena Council who represents a
4 waterfront community;

5 (3) 1 member of the Pasadena Sport Fishermen's Group;

6 (4) 1 member of the Anne Arundel County Watermen's Association;

7 (5) 1 member of the Maryland Saltwater Sport Fishermen's
8 Association;

9 (6) 1 individual who represents the pleasure boating industry in Anne
10 Arundel County;

11 (7) 1 member of the Pasadena Business Association;

12 (8) 1 resident of legislative district 31; and

13 (9) 1 resident of legislative district [47A] 46.

14 (c) The Oversight Committee shall:

15 (1) Monitor the redeposit of Anne Arundel County tributary spoil and
16 other spoil in the Cox Creek area;

17 (2) Hear and dispose of complaints lodged by individuals affected by
18 the redeposit of Anne Arundel County tributary spoil and other spoil in the Cox Creek
19 area; and

20 (3) Appoint a member from the Committee to serve as a liaison to the
21 Innovative Use Advisory Council.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2014.
