- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

(c) "Certified applicator" means a person who is certified by the Secretaryunder this subtitle.

1 (r) "Restricted use pesticide" means a pesticide so classified by the provisions 2 in this title or by the federal government or the Secretary of Agriculture, State of 3 Maryland.

5 (a) In this section, "cyclodiene termiticide" means chlordane (1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 6 8, 8-octachloro-2, 3, 3a, 4, 7, 7a-hexahydro-4, 7-methanoindene), heptachlor (1, 4, 5, 7 6, 7, 8, 8-heptachloro-3a, 4, 7, 7a-tetrahydro-4, 7-methanoindene), aldrin (1, 2, 3, 4, 8 10, 10-hexachloro-1, 4, 4a, 5, 8, 8a-hexahydro-1, 4:5, 8-dimethanonaphthalene), and 9 dieldrin (3, 4, 5, 6, 9, 9-hexachloro-1a, 2, 2a, 3, 6, 6a, 7, 7a-octahydro-2, 7:3, 10 6-dimethanonaphth (2, 3-b) oxirene) and related cyclodiene chemical compounds used 11 for the control of termites.

12 (b) (1) [On and after October 1, 1987, each] EACH cyclodiene termiticide 13 distributed, sold, or offered for sale in [this] THE State shall be classified as a 14 restricted use pesticide.

15 (2) A person may distribute, sell, or offer for sale a cyclodiene 16 termiticide only if:

17 (i) The cyclodiene termiticide is designated as a restricted use18 pesticide in a manner determined by the Department; and

- 201.Certified [pesticide] applicator; or

21 2. Registered employee who has completed a course in
 22 termiticide application that is approved by the Department.

23 (3) A cyclodiene termiticide applied by a licensee shall only be applied24 by:

25 (i) A certified [pesticide] applicator; or

(ii) A registered employee who has completed a course in
termiticide application that is approved by the Department and is making the
application under the direct supervision of a certified [pesticide] applicator.

29 (C) (1) EACH NEONICOTINOID PESTICIDE DISTRIBUTED, SOLD, OR 30 OFFERED FOR SALE IN THE STATE SHALL BE CLASSIFIED AS A RESTRICTED USE 31 PESTICIDE.

32 (2) A PERSON MAY DISTRIBUTE, SELL, OR OFFER FOR SALE A 33 NEONICOTINOID PESTICIDE ONLY IF:

1(I)THE NEONICOTINOID PESTICIDE IS DESIGNATED AS A2RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE IN A MANNER DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT;3AND

4 (II) THE PURCHASER IS A CERTIFIED APPLICATOR.

5 (3) A NEONICOTINOID PESTICIDE SHALL BE APPLIED ONLY BY A 6 CERTIFIED APPLICATOR.

7 [(c)] (D) [Before October 1, 1987, the] **THE** Department shall adopt 8 regulations to carry out the provisions of this section.
