19 20 Public Schools – Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Automated External

Defibrillator Instruction – Graduation Requirement

(Breanna's Law)

FOR the purpose of requiring a public school student to complete instruction in eardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator to graduate from high school beginning with students entering a certain grade in a certain year; requiring each county board of education to provide instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator in certain schools beginning in a certain year, using a certain instructional program, and incorporating certain skills; requiring, if the instruction is offered for certification, a certain individual to conduct the instruction providing that a certain instructional course may not be offered for a certain certification; authorizing, if the instruction is not offered for certification, a certain individual to facilitate, provide, or oversee the instruction; requiring the State Department of Education to develop a process to monitor the implementation of certain provisions of law; defining certain terms; and generally relating to instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator and high school graduation requirements for certain public school students in the State.
