## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Natural Resources – Forests, Parks, and Recreation Areas – Posted Notice of**  
3 **Safety Information**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to post a certain  
5 notice in a certain location at each State forest, park, and recreational area that  
6 contains certain safety information; and generally relating to forests, parks, and  
7 recreation areas.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article – Natural Resources  
10 Section 5–211  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2012 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Natural Resources**

16 5–211.

17 The Department shall [prepare]:

18 **(1) PREPARE**, print, and distribute on request, matter relating to the  
19 State forests, parks, scenic preserves, parkways, historic monuments, and recreational  
20 areas; **AND**

21 **(2) POST A NOTICE IN A CONSPICUOUS LOCATION AT EACH STATE**  
22 **FOREST, PARK, AND RECREATIONAL AREA THAT CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING**  
23 **INFORMATION:**

1                   **(I) ANY RULES APPLICABLE TO THE STATE FOREST, PARK,**  
2 **OR RECREATIONAL AREA;**

3                   **(II) THE LOCATION OF ANY HUNTING ZONES IN THE STATE**  
4 **FOREST, PARK, OR RECREATIONAL AREA;**

5                   **(III) THE LOCATION OF ANY HAZARD OR DANGER IN THE**  
6 **STATE FOREST, PARK, OR RECREATIONAL AREA;**

7                   **(IV) THE PHYSICAL ADDRESS FOR THE STATE FOREST,**  
8 **PARK, OR RECREATIONAL AREA;**

9                   **(V) THE EMERGENCY TELEPHONE NUMBER FOR THE STATE**  
10 **FOREST, PARK, OR RECREATIONAL AREA; AND**

11                   **(VI) 9-1-1 AS THE EMERGENCY TELEPHONE NUMBER FOR**  
12 **GENERAL EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE.**

13                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
14 October 1, 2014.
