Developmental Disabilities – Residential Programs – Reimbursement for Visitation Absence Days

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to 4 5 reimburse certain providers of services to individuals with developmental disabilities in certain residential programs for a visitation absence day; 6 7 prohibiting the Department from imposing certain limitations on certain 8 reimbursement to certain providers for visitation absence days; prohibiting 9 certain providers from charging certain individuals in certain residential programs for a visitation absence day; prohibiting the Department from using a 10 certain rate-setting methodology for certain providers for a certain purpose; 11 12defining certain terms; and generally relating to providers of services to individuals with developmental disabilities and reimbursement for visitation 13 14 absence days.

- 3 (3) "RATE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 7-307 OF THIS 4 SUBTITLE.
- 5 (4) "RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM" MEANS A COMMUNITY-BASED 6 RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS IN AN
- 7 ALTERNATIVE LIVING UNIT OR A GROUP HOME.
- 8 (5) "VISITATION ABSENCE DAY" MEANS AN ABSENCE OF AN
- 9 INDIVIDUAL FROM A RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM FOR A FULL 24-HOUR PERIOD OF
- 10 A DAY WHEN THE INDIVIDUAL IS UNABLE TO BE IN RESIDENTIAL SERVICES DUE

- 12 **(B) (1)** THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REIMBURSE A COMMUNITY 13 PROVIDER FOR A VISITATION ABSENCE DAY.

- 18 (C) A COMMUNITY PROVIDER MAY NOT CHARGE AN INDIVIDUAL IN A 19 RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM FOR A VISITATION ABSENCE DAY.
- 20 (D) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT USE A RATE-SETTING METHODOLOGY
- 21 THAT REDUCES FUNDING FOR OTHER COST FACTORS WHEN ESTABLISHING THE
- 22 RATE OF REIMBURSEMENT FOR COMMUNITY PROVIDERS WHEN PROVIDING THE
- 23 REIMBURSEMENT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
