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5 (a) (1) The Advisory Council shall be composed of [18] **19** members as 6 follows:

7 (i) One member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the 8 President of the Senate;

9 (ii) One member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the 10 Speaker of the House;

11 (iii) The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, or the 12 Secretary's designee;

- 13 (iv) The Secretary of the Environment, or the Secretary's 14 designee;
 - (v) The Secretary of Agriculture, or the Secretary's designee;
- 16 (vi) The Secretary of Education, or the Secretary's designee;
- 17 (vii) The Secretary of Human Resources, or the Secretary's 18 designee;
- 19 (viii) The Secretary of Housing and Community Development, or20 the Secretary's designee;
- (ix) The Special Secretary of the Governor's Office for Children,
 Youth, and Families, or the Special Secretary's designee;
- (x) Two licensed [pediatric] health care providers with expertise
 in the field of children's environmental health, appointed by the Governor;
- (xi) One representative from [the Johns Hopkins University] AN
 ACADEMIC INSTITUTION who has expertise in studying the impact of environmental
 [allergies] EXPOSURES on childhood [asthma] DISEASE, appointed by the Governor;
- (xii) One parent or guardian whose child has been clinically
 diagnosed as having been exposed to environmental health hazards including lead
 paint or pesticides, appointed by the Governor;

$\frac{3}{4}$	(xiv) One economist skilled in measuring the economic costs of illness and the benefits of prevention, appointed by the Governor;

$\begin{array}{c} 16 \\ 17 \end{array}$	(3) The Secretary of the Environment or the Secretary's designee shall serve as the vice chairman.
18	(b) (1) The term of a member is 4 years.
$\begin{array}{c} 19\\ 20 \end{array}$	(2) The terms of the members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Advisory Council on October 1, 2000.

$\frac{23}{24}$	(4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
