- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 SECTION 14. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 13 of $\mathbf{2}$ this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005. Section 3 of this Act shall remain 3 effective for a period of [10] 20 years and, at the end of June 30, [2015] 2025, with no 4 further action required by the General Assembly, Section 3 of this Act shall be $\mathbf{5}$ abrogated and of no further force and effect. Section 5 of this Act shall remain 6 effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2007, with no further action 7required by the General Assembly, Section 5 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no 8 further force and effect.

11 SECTION 14. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 13 of 12this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005. Section 3 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of [10] 20 years and, at the end of June 30, [2015] 2025, with no 13further action required by the General Assembly, Section 3 of this Act shall be 14abrogated and of no further force and effect. Section 5 of this Act shall remain 15effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2007, with no further action 16required by the General Assembly, Section 5 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no 1718 further force and effect.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect20 October 1, 2014.
