AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Calvert County, Orphans' Court Judges for Calvert County, or Calvert County Treasurer while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Calvert County, Orphans' Court Judges for Calvert County, or Calvert County Treasurer shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.  SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
