3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Baltimore County School Board Nominating 4 Commission; providing for the membership, duties, terms, and staffing of the $\mathbf{5}$ Commission; requiring the Governor to designate a chair of the Commission; 6 requiring the Governor to make appointments to the Baltimore County Board of 7 Education from a list of nominees submitted to the Governor by the 8 Commission; providing that a member's appointment to the Baltimore County 9 Board of Education is subject to approval or rejection by the registered voters of Baltimore County at the general election following the appointment: and 10 generally relating to the Baltimore County School Board Nominating 11 12Commission and appointments to the Baltimore County Board of Education.
