1 (c) "Correctional officer" means an employee of the Department working in a 2 State correctional facility who serves in the classification of correctional officer [I,] II, 3 sergeant, lieutenant, captain, or major, and includes:

4	(1)	a correctional dietary officer;
5	(2)	a correctional maintenance officer;
6	(3)	a correctional laundry officer;
7	(4)	a correctional recreation officer; and
8	(5)	a correctional supply officer.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2014.
