## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Commission on Child Custody Decision Making – Extension**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the dates by which the Commission on Child Custody  
4 Decision Making is required to submit an interim report and final report of its  
5 findings and recommendations; extending the termination date of the  
6 Commission; and generally relating to the Commission on Child Custody  
7 Decision Making.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Chapter 633 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2013  
10 Section 1(g) and 2

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Chapter 633 of the Acts of 2013**

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That:

16 (g) The Commission shall:

17 (1) be appointed, organized, and begin its deliberations no later than  
18 September 1, 2013;

19 (2) submit an interim report of its findings and recommendations to  
20 the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the  
21 General Assembly, on or before December 31, [2013] **2014**; and

1                   (3)     submit a final report of its findings and any recommendations for  
2 legislation to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government  
3 Article, the General Assembly, on or before December 1, ~~[2014]~~ **2015**.

4                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
5 July 1, 2013. It shall remain effective for a period of ~~[1 year]~~ **2 YEARS** and 6 months  
6 and, at the end of December 31, ~~[2014]~~ **2015**, with no further action required by the  
7 General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

8                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 July 1, 2014.
