A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Department of Health and Mental Hygiene – Newborn Screening Program Fund – Establishment

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Newborn Screening Program Fund; requiring the $\mathbf{5}$ Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to administer the Fund; providing for 6 the uses, purposes, sources of funding, investment of money, and auditing of the 7 Fund; providing that the Fund is a continuing, nonlapsing fund not subject to 8 certain provisions of law; requiring the Secretary to pay certain fees to the 9 Comptroller; requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain fees to the Fund; 10 defining a certain term; and generally relating to the Newborn Screening 11 Program Fund in the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.
