## 2 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene – Newborn Screening Program 3 Fund – Establishment

- FOR the purpose of establishing the Newborn Screening Program Fund; requiring the 4 5 Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to administer the Fund; providing for 6 the uses, purposes, sources of funding, investment of money, and auditing of the 7 Fund; providing that the Fund is a continuing, nonlapsing fund not subject to 8 certain provisions of law; requiring the Secretary to pay certain fees to the 9 Comptroller; requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain fees to the Fund; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the Newborn Screening 10 Program Fund in the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene. 11

- 5 (2) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE FEES TO THE FUND NEWBORN SCREENING PROGRAM FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 13–113

- 9 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE NEWBORN SCREENING 10 PROGRAM FUND.
- 11 (B) THERE IS A NEWBORN SCREENING PROGRAM FUND.
- 12 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE 13 SCREENING OF NEWBORN INFANTS IN THE STATE FOR CERTAIN HEREDITARY 14 AND CONGENITAL DISORDERS.
- 15 (D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.
- 16 (E) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- 18 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- 20 **(F)** THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
- 21 (1) REVENUE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FUND UNDER § 13–111(F) OF 22 THIS SUBTITLE;
- 23 (2) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND; 24 AND
- 25 (3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED 26 FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
- 27 (G) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY TO COVER THE ADMINISTRATIVE, 28 LABORATORY, AND FOLLOW-UP COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PERFORMANCE
- 29 OF NEWBORN SCREENING TESTS CONDUCTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

$\frac{1}{2}$	(H) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.
$\frac{3}{4}$	(I) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
5 6 7	(J) THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR SHALL AUDIT THE ACCOUNTS AND TRANSACTIONS OF THE FUND AS PROVIDED IN § 2–1220 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
