CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Wicomico County – Orphans’ Court Judges – Salaries**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of each judge of the Orphans’ Court for
4 Wicomico County; providing for the application of this Act; and generally
5 relating to the compensation of judges of the Orphans’ Court for Wicomico
6 County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Estates and Trusts**

15 2–108.

16 (w) Each judge of the Court for Wicomico County shall receive an annual
17 salary of [~~\$6,400~~] **\$9,500** to be paid quarterly. Each judge shall also receive an annual
18 allowance for traveling expenses of \$1,560 to be paid quarterly.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
2 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
3 the salary or compensation of a judge of the Orphans' Court for Wicomico County
4 while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the
5 provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of a judge of the Orphans'
6 Court for Wicomico County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following
7 term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected
8 after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2014.
