SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 1 2 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of a judge of the Orphans' Court for Wicomico County 3 while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the 4 provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of a judge of the Orphans' 5 Court for Wicomico County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following 6 7 term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected 8 after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term. 9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014. 10
