13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 Article Education
- 16 **15–118.**

17(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION18INSTITUTION AND A COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN THE STATE.

FOR BEGINNING IN THE 2014–2015 ACADEMIC YEAR, FOR 1 **(B)** (1) $\mathbf{2}$ ALL FIRST-TIME, FULL-TIME UNDERGRADUATE FRESHMEN, AN INSTITUTION OF 3 HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL PROVIDE TO THE STUDENT INFORMATION ON THE 4 COST OF HIGHER EDUCATION AT THE INSTITUTION BY COMPLETING AND MAILING OR PROVIDING ELECTRONICALLY, AT A MINIMUM, THE INFORMATION $\mathbf{5}$ CONTAINED ON THE FORM KNOWN AS THE FINANCIAL AID SHOPPING SHEET, 6 AS PROMULGATED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. 7

8 (2) THE FINANCIAL AID SHOPPING SHEET SHALL BE MAILED OR 9 PROVIDED ELECTRONICALLY TO THE STUDENT AT THE SAME TIME THAT AN 10 AWARD OF FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID IS MAILED OR PROVIDED ELECTRONICALLY 11 TO THE STUDENT.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 July 1, 2014.
