Public Ethics - Regulated Lobbyists - Certification to Authorize Lobbying and Electronic Filing of Registration

- FOR the purpose of requiring a certain regulated lobbyist to certify under oath or
 affirmation that the regulated lobbyist is authorized to engage in lobbying for a
 certain entity; providing for the contents of the certification; authorizing a
 regulated lobbyist registration to be filed electronically; requiring an
 electronically filed registration to include a certain certification made by an
 electronic signature; making conforming changes; and generally relating to
 public ethics and the regulation of lobbyists.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24October 1, 2014.

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
