## A BILL ENTITLED

## AN ACT concerning

## State Personnel - Child Day Care Financial Assistance Program

FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Budget and Management to establish by regulation a program that provides financial assistance to certain State employees for certain child day care services; providing that the program shall apply only to child day care services provided to children under a certain age; defining a certain term; and generally relating to State personnel and financial assistance for child day care services.

## BY adding to

Article - State Personnel and Pensions
Section 10-405
Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - State Personnel and Pensions

10-405.
(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEE" MEANS AN Employee In the State Personnel Management System who has COMPLETED AT LEAST 12 MONTHS OF CONTINUOUS EMPLOYMENT WITH THE STATE.
(2) "ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEE" DOES NOT INCLUDE A TEMPORARY EMPLOYEE.

(B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE SECRETARY BY REGULATION SHALL ESTABLISH A PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES FOR CHILD DAY CARE SERVICES PROVIDED TO CHILDREN OF ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES.
(C) THE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY ONLY TO CHILD DAY CARE SERVICES PROVIDED TO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 4 YEARS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
