FOR the purpose of providing that the student member of the Anne Arundel County
Board of Education may not vote on certain matters; authorizing the board, by
majority vote of the elected members, to determine whether a matter before the
board concerns a subject on which the student member is prohibited from voting
under this Act; and generally relating to voting rights of the student member of
the Anne Arundel County Board of Education.
