Statewide Information Technology Master Plan – Inclusion of Cybersecurity Framework – Requirement

FOR the purpose of requiring that the statewide information technology master plan
developed by the Secretary of Information Technology include a cybersecurity
framework; requiring that the Secretary consider materials developed by the
National Institute of Standards and Technology in developing or modifying the
cybersecurity framework; and generally relating to the inclusion of a
cybersecurity framework in the statewide information technology master plan.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – State Finance and Procurement

18 3A–304.

19 **(A)** The Secretary shall develop a statewide information technology master 20 plan.

(B) (1) THE STATEWIDE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY MASTER PLAN DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE A CYBERSECURITY FRAMEWORK.

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1 (2) IN DEVELOPING OR MODIFYING THE CYBERSECURITY 2 FRAMEWORK REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE 3 SECRETARY SHALL CONSIDER MATERIALS DEVELOPED BY THE NATIONAL 4 INSTITUTE OF STANDARDS AND TECHNOLOGY.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2014.
