3 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that the election of certain officers of
4 the State Board of Pharmacy be from among the pharmacist members of the
5 Board; and generally relating to the election of officers of the State Board of
6 Pharmacy.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Health Occupations**

15 12–203.

16 (a) From among its [pharmacist] members, the Board annually shall elect a
17 president, a secretary, and a treasurer.
