coverage arising out of contact with a dog under certain circumstances;

Article – Insurance

19–216.

(A) AN INSURER MAY NOT REFUSE TO ISSUE OR RENEW A POLICY OF
 HOMEOWNER'S OR RENTER'S INSURANCE SOLELY BECAUSE THE APPLICANT OR
 INSURED OWNS A DOG, REGARDLESS OF THE BREED OF DOG.

(B) A POLICY OF HOMEOWNER'S OR RENTER'S INSURANCE THAT
PROVIDES LIABILITY COVERAGE MAY NOT EXCLUDE COVERAGE FOR BODILY
INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE, OR MEDICAL PAYMENTS ARISING OUT OF DIRECT

PHYSICAL CONTACT WITH A DOG THAT IS OWNED BY OR IN THE CARE, CUSTODY, OR CONTROL OF AN INSURED UNDER THE POLICY.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all 4 policies of homeowner's or renter's insurance issued, delivered, or renewed in the State 5 on or after October 1, 2014.

6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2014.
