## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County – Board of Education – Selection of Members**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a procedure for the election and appointment of  
4 certain members of the Baltimore County Board of Education; repealing certain  
5 provisions governing the appointment of all members of the county board;  
6 establishing the composition of the county board; providing for the  
7 qualifications, terms of office, and the filling of a vacancy of certain members of  
8 the county board; requiring the elected members of the county board to reside  
9 in, be a registered voter in, and be elected from certain districts; specifying that  
10 a member may not be elected or appointed to serve for more than a certain  
11 number of consecutive terms; establishing the Baltimore County School Board  
12 Nominating Commission; providing for the membership, duties, terms, and  
13 staffing of the Commission; requiring the Governor to designate a chair of the  
14 Commission; requiring the Governor to make appointments to the Baltimore  
15 County Board of Education from a list of nominees submitted to the Governor

11           **(B)    IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBTITLE 2A OF**

13 **OF MEMBERS WHO ARE ELECTED AND APPOINTED.**

14           **[(b)] (C)**    In Caroline County, in accordance with Subtitle 3A of this title, the  
15 members of the county board shall be a combination of members who are elected and  
16 appointed.

17           **[(c)] (D)**    In Harford County, in accordance with Subtitle 6A of this title, the  
18 members of the county board shall be a combination of members who are elected and  
19 appointed.

20           **[(d)] (E)**    In Prince George's County, in accordance with Subtitle 10 of this  
21 title, the members of the county board shall be a combination of members who are  
22 elected and appointed.

23           **[(e)] (F)**    An individual subject to the authority of the county board may not  
24 serve as a member of the county board. At the time of filing a certificate of candidacy  
25 for election to a county board, a person shall certify to the local board of supervisors of  
26 elections whether or not he is subject to the authority of the county board. The  
27 Governor shall not issue a commission of election to a person who has certified  
28 affirmatively and who is elected to a county board until the member-elect offers proof  
29 that he is no longer subject to the authority of the county board.



1                   (II) A MEMBER FROM A DISTRICT WHO DOES NOT MAINTAIN  
2 RESIDENCY IN THAT DISTRICT MAY NOT CONTINUE AS A MEMBER OF THE  
3 COUNTY BOARD AND THE OFFICE SHALL BE DEEMED VACANT.

4                   (III) IF THE BOUNDARY LINE OF A DISTRICT IS CHANGED,  
5 THE TERM OF AN INCUMBENT MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD WHO NO  
6 LONGER RESIDES IN THE DISTRICT BECAUSE OF THE CHANGE IS NOT AFFECTED  
7 DURING THIS TERM.

8                   (4) (I) A MEMBER MAY NOT BE ELECTED OR APPOINTED TO  
9 SERVE ON THE COUNTY BOARD FOR MORE THAN THREE CONSECUTIVE TERMS.

10                   (II) A MEMBER WHO HAS SERVED THREE CONSECUTIVE  
11 4-YEAR TERMS MAY NOT BE ELECTED OR APPOINTED TO THE COUNTY BOARD  
12 UNTIL AT LEAST 4 YEARS HAVE ELAPSED SINCE THE END OF THE MEMBER'S  
13 LAST TERM ON THE COUNTY BOARD.

12 appointed members of the Baltimore County Board of Education shall expire as  
13 follows:

14           (a) The terms of the four members appointed at large who are in office on the  
15 effective date of this Act shall expire as follows:

16           (1) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June  
17 30, 2015, shall expire at the end of December 6, 2015, and the Governor shall appoint  
18 a member to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on  
19 December 7, 2015, until a successor is appointed and qualifies;

20           (2) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June  
21 30, 2016, shall expire at the end of December 4, 2016, and the Governor shall appoint  
22 a member to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on  
23 December 5, 2016, until a successor is appointed and qualifies; and

24           (3) the terms of the two members whose terms are scheduled to expire  
25 on June 30, 2018, shall expire at the end of December 2, 2018, and the Governor shall  
26 appoint two members from a list of nominees submitted by the Baltimore County  
27 School Board Nominating Commission as established by Section 1 of this Act to  
28 succeed those two departing members, each to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on  
29 December 3, 2018, until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

30           (b) The terms of the seven members appointed from councilmanic districts 1,
