# A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## **Baltimore County – Board of Education – Selection of Members**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a procedure for the election and appointment of 4 certain members of the Baltimore County Board of Education; repealing certain  $\mathbf{5}$ provisions governing the appointment of all members of the county board; 6 establishing the composition of the county board; providing for the 7 qualifications, terms of office, and the filling of a vacancy of certain members of 8 the county board; requiring the elected members of the county board to reside 9 in, be a registered voter in, and be elected from certain districts; specifying that a member may not be elected or appointed to serve for more than a certain 10 number of consecutive terms; providing for a student member of the county 11 12board; providing for the term and duties of the student member; providing for 13 the removal of, and hearings and appeal procedures for, certain members of the county board; providing for the election of the chair and vice chair of the county 1415board; providing for the compensation of the members of the county board; 16 providing for the termination of the terms of the appointed members of the 17county board; making certain conforming nomenclature changes; and generally relating to the election and appointment of members of the Baltimore County 18 Board of Education. 19

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the 29 appointed members of the Baltimore County Board of Education shall expire as 30 follows:

(a) The terms of the four members appointed at large who are in office on the
 effective date of this Act shall expire as follows:

(1) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June
30, 2015, shall expire at the end of December 6, 2015, and the Governor shall appoint

a member to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning onDecember 7, 2015, until a successor is appointed and qualifies;

3 (2) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 4 30, 2016, shall expire at the end of December 4, 2016, and the Governor shall appoint 5 a member to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on 6 December 5, 2016, until a successor is appointed and qualifies; and

7 (3) the terms of the two members whose terms are scheduled to expire 8 on June 30, 2018, shall expire at the end of December 2, 2018, and the Governor shall 9 appoint two members to succeed those two departing members, each to serve for a 10 term of 4 years beginning on December 3, 2018, until a successor is appointed and 11 qualifies.

12 (b) The terms of the seven members appointed from councilmanic districts 1, 13 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Baltimore County, or their successors, who are in office on the 14 effective date of this Act, shall terminate at the end of December 4, 2016, and the 15 members elected from those councilmanic/school board districts in Baltimore County 16 at the general election in November 2016, shall succeed those appointed members and 17 serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 5, 2016, until a successor is elected 18 and qualifies.

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the initial elected 20 members of the Baltimore County Board of Education as provided under this Act shall 21 be elected from the seven councilmanic/school board districts in Baltimore County at 22 the general election in November 2016 and take office on December 5, 2016.

23 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, in appointing members 24 to the Baltimore County Board of Education, the Governor shall ensure, to the extent 25 practicable, that the total makeup of the county board reflects gender, ethnic, and 26 racial diversity.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October 1, 2014.
