A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Alcoholic Beverages – Montgomery County – Beer Festivals

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing Montgomery County to conduct a beer festival not 4 more than a certain number of times each year under the supervision of the $\mathbf{5}$ Montgomery County Department of Liquor Control; requiring the county, in 6 selecting a nonprofit festival organization to organize the beer festival, to 7 ensure that the organization has certain experience; specifying that the festival 8 organization select the weekends during which the festival will be conducted; 9 authorizing a festival organization to contract with holders of certain current alcoholic beverages licenses to sell and display beer at the festival; specifying 10 that on the days and for the hours designated for the beer festival, beer may be 11 12displayed and sold at retail under certain conditions; requiring a festival 13 organization to choose the festival location and ensure that the primary focus of the festival is the promotion of Maryland beer; requiring that a person hold a 14special beer festival license and contract with the festival organization before 1516 selling, offering for sale, or displaying beer at a festival; authorizing the 17Montgomery County Board of License Commissioners to issue a special beer 18 festival license: establishing a license fee; allowing certain persons to hold a 19special beer festival license in addition to another license; providing for certain 20penalties; requiring certain license fees to be deposited into the general fund of the county; requiring the Montgomery County Board of License Commissioners 2122to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to 23beer festivals in Montgomery County.

18 19 20 21	(C) UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF LIQUOR CONTROL, THE COUNTY EACH YEAR MAY CONDUCT THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BEER FESTIVAL ON NOT MORE THAN FOUR WEEKENDS THAT A FESTIVAL ORGANIZATION SELECTS.
22 23 24 25 26	(D) A FESTIVAL ORGANIZATION MAY CONTRACT WITH HOLDERS OF A CURRENT MONTGOMERY COUNTY RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE, A STATE CLASS 5 BREWERY LICENSE, A STATE CLASS 6 PUB-BREWERY LICENSE, OR A STATE CLASS 7 MICRO-BREWERY LICENSE TO SELL AND DISPLAY BEER AT THE FESTIVAL.
27 28	(E) ON THE DAYS AND FOR THE HOURS DESIGNATED FOR THE FESTIVAL, BEER MAY BE DISPLAYED AND SOLD AT RETAIL:

1 (F) A FESTIVAL ORGANIZATION: $\mathbf{2}$ (1) SHALL CHOOSE FOR THE FESTIVAL A LOCATION IN THE COUNTY THAT MAY BE A LICENSED OR AN UNLICENSED PREMISES; AND 3 4 (2) SHALL ENSURE THAT THE PRIMARY FOCUS OF THE FESTIVAL 5 IS THE PROMOTION OF MARYLAND BEER. 6 (G) (1) BEFORE A PERSON MAY SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR DISPLAY 7BEER AT A FESTIVAL, THE PERSON MUST CONTRACT WITH THE FESTIVAL 8 ORGANIZATION AND OBTAIN A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE FROM THE 9 BOARD. 10 (2) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE. 11 (3) THE LICENSE FEE IS \$30 FOR EACH DAY OF THE FESTIVAL. 12(4) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A PERSON MAY HOLD A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE IN ADDITION TO 13 14ANOTHER LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS ARTICLE. 15(5) THE BOARD MAY DENY A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE 16TO ANY APPLICANT, SUSPEND OR REVOKE A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE, OR IMPOSE A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$20,000 IF THE APPLICANT OR LICENSE 17HOLDER VIOLATES A PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE OR THE REGULATIONS OF 18 THE BOARD. 19 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, ALL 20(6) 21LICENSE FEES COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED 22INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE COUNTY. 23**(H)** THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING THIS 24SECTION. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2526July 1, 2014.
