A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County – Barbershops – Restriction on Operation Repealed**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain restriction prohibiting a barbershop in
4 Montgomery County from being open for business more than a certain number
5 of days per week; and generally relating to barbershops in Montgomery County.

6 BY repealing

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

14 [4–606.

15 A barbershop in Montgomery County may not open for business more than 6
16 days a week.]

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 2014.
