## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Public Utilities - Fixed Charges for Taxicab Services - Baltimore City

- FOR the purpose of authorizing a taxicab permit holder to make a fixed charge for any trip by taxicab between certain locations in Baltimore City or between points within Baltimore City as approved by the Public Service Commission; requiring that a fixed charge made under this Act be calculated on a mileage basis approved by the Commission; and generally relating to fixed charges for taxicab services.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (a) (1) A taxicab permit holder shall post in each of its taxicabs a schedule 19 of its fares on a rate card.
- 20 (2) The rate card shall be printed and arranged in a way that allows a passenger to determine readily the exact fare payable by the passenger.
- 22 (3) A person may not collect a fare other than a fare appearing on or 23 determinable from the rate card posted in the taxicab.



$\frac{1}{2}$	(b) (1) This subsection does not apply to a taxicab operating in the City of Hagerstown.
3 4 5	(2) (i) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, while in service, each taxicab for which a permit is required shall be equipped with an accurate taximeter that is properly installed and connected.
6 7	(ii) The taximeter shall be the exclusive means of measuring the charges for service and is subject to inspection and testing by the Commission.
8	(c) (1) A fixed charge may be made for any trip by taxicab between:
9 10	(I) a point within the political subdivision in which the taxicab is normally operated and a point outside of the political subdivision;
11 12	(II) THE MARYLAND PORT ADMINISTRATION'S CRUISE TERMINAL FACILITIES AND:
13	1. FORT MCHENRY;
14 15	2. THE WORLD TRADE CENTER INSTITUTE IN BALTIMORE; OR
16	3. PENN STATION IN BALTIMORE; OR
17 18	(III) POINTS WITHIN BALTIMORE CITY, AS APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION.
19 20	(2) [The] $\bf A$ fixed charge shall be calculated on a mileage basis that the Commission approves.
