13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Correctional Services

16 **7–103.**

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1 **(B)** THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION TO 2 AN OFFENDER WHO:

3 (1) WAS SUPERVISED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER CONDITIONS 4 OF:

- 5 (I) PAROLE;
- 6 (II) PROBATION; OR
- 7 (III) MANDATORY RELEASE SUPERVISION;

8 (2) HAS COMPLETED ALL SPECIAL AND GENERAL CONDITIONS OF
9 SUPERVISION, INCLUDING PAYING ALL REQUIRED RESTITUTION, FINES, FEES,
10 AND OTHER PAYMENT OBLIGATIONS; AND

11(3) IS NO LONGER UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE12DEPARTMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December
31, 2014, the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services shall report to the
Governor and, subject to § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General
Assembly on the number of certificates of completion issued under this Act.

17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 18 construed to apply prospectively and applies only to individuals under the supervision 19 of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services on or after July 1, 2014.

20 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2014.
