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Maryland Uniform Commercial Code – Secured Transactions – Notice of Filing of Financing Statement

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Assessments and Taxation or
other office that receives a <u>certain</u> financing statement for filing to provide a
certain notice of the filing to the debtor identified on the financing statement
under certain circumstances; requiring the Department or other office required
to provide the notice to determine the form of the notice; requiring the notice to
contain certain information; <u>providing for the application of this Act</u>; and
generally relating to secured transactions and the filing of financing statements.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 (C) THE REMEDIES AVAILABLE TO THE DEBTOR IF THE 2 DEBTOR BELIEVES THAT THE FINANCING STATEMENT IS ERRONEOUSLY OR 3 FRAUDULENTLY FILED.
