- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Department of Education to include 5 operating funds for the Maryland Library for the Blind and Physically 6 Handicapped in its budget; requiring the Maryland Library for the Blind and 7 Physically Handicapped to receive a certain amount of funding each year 8 beginning in a certain fiscal year; requiring the Department to disburse funds to 9 the Maryland Library for the Blind and Physically Handicapped; and generally 10 relating to funding for the Maryland Library for the Blind and Physically Handicapped. 11
