A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Government – Administrative Procedure Act – Effective Date of**
3 **Adopted Regulations**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the effective date of certain regulations adopted under the
5 Administrative Procedure Act; and generally relating to regulations adopted
6 under the Administrative Procedure Act.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Government**

15 10–117.

16 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this section or in
17 other law, the effective date of a regulation is:

18 (I) **JANUARY 1 IF THE NOTICE OF ADOPTION IS PUBLISHED**
19 **IN THE REGISTER DURING THE PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 1 THROUGH**
20 **NOVEMBER 30, BOTH INCLUSIVE;**

21 (II) **APRIL 1 IF THE NOTICE OF ADOPTION IS PUBLISHED IN**
22 **THE REGISTER DURING THE PERIOD FROM DECEMBER 1 THROUGH FEBRUARY**
23 **29, BOTH INCLUSIVE;**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(III) JULY 1 IF THE NOTICE OF ADOPTION IS PUBLISHED IN**
2 **THE REGISTER DURING THE PERIOD FROM MARCH 1 THROUGH MAY 31, BOTH**
3 **INCLUSIVE;**

4 **(IV) OCTOBER 1 IF THE NOTICE OF ADOPTION IS PUBLISHED**
5 **IN THE REGISTER DURING THE PERIOD FROM JUNE 1 THROUGH AUGUST 31,**
6 **BOTH INCLUSIVE;**

7 **[(i)] (V)** the 10th calendar day after notice of adoption is
8 published in the Register **IF:**

9 **1. THE UNIT IS REQUIRED TO ADOPT THE PROPOSED**
10 **REGULATION BY FEDERAL LAW;**

11 **2. THE REGULATION RELATES TO AIR POLLUTION;**

12 **3. THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL**
13 **HYGIENE OR THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING, AND REGULATION IS**
14 **REQUIRED BY STATE LAW TO ADOPT THE REGULATION ON OR BEFORE A**
15 **SPECIFIED DATE WITHIN 12 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LAW;**

16 **4. THE REGULATION RELATES TO THE MARYLAND**
17 **MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER TITLE 15 OF THE**
18 **HEALTH – GENERAL ARTICLE;**

19 **5. THE REGULATION RELATES TO THE**
20 **IMPLEMENTATION OF FEDERAL HEALTH CARE REFORM UNDER THE FEDERAL**
21 **PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE ACT;**

22 **6. THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL**
23 **HYGIENE FINDS THAT AN EARLIER EFFECTIVE DATE IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT**
24 **THE HEALTH OR SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE STATE;**

25 **7. THE REGULATION IS ADOPTED BY THE**
26 **DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES; OR**

27 **8. THE REGULATION IS ADOPTED BY THE MARYLAND**
28 **STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE MARYLAND STATE DEPARTMENT OF**
29 **EDUCATION; or**

30 **[(ii)] (VI)** a later date that the notice sets.

31 (2) For calculation of the effective date under this subsection:

1 (i) Article 1, § 36 of the Code does not apply;

2 (ii) the issue date of the Register in which the notice is
3 published is not counted; and

4 (iii) each other calendar day, including Saturdays, Sundays, and
5 legal holidays, is counted.

6 (b) The effective date of a regulation after its emergency adoption is the date
7 that the Committee sets.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2014.
