1 [(i)] (1) hold a tip jar license or wholesaler's license or be 2 employed by a person who holds a tip jar license or wholesaler's license; or

3 [(ii)] (2) hold an ownership interest in or receive a direct 4 benefit from a person who holds a tip jar license or wholesaler's license.

5 [(2) If a member of the gaming commission serves on the board of 6 directors or as an officer of an organization and that organization applies for funds 7 from the gaming commission, the member shall cease immediately to serve on the 8 gaming commission.]

#### 9 (F) THE GAMING COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT CONFLICT OF INTEREST 10 REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO MEMBERS OF THE GAMING COMMISSION.

# SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2014.
