4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to allow a  
5 person to hunt deer on certain property on certain Sundays in ~~Allegany County,~~  
6 ~~Frederick County, Garrett County, and Washington County~~ subject to certain  
7 provisions of law; making conforming changes; and generally relating to the  
8 regulation of deer hunting by the Department of Natural Resources.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Natural Resources**

4 10–410.

5 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), (4), (6), [and] (7), AND  
6 (8) of this subsection, a person may not hunt any game bird or mammal on Sundays.

7 (2) The following persons may hunt the specified game birds and  
8 mammals on Sundays:

9 (i) A person using State certified raptors to hunt game birds or  
10 mammals during open season;

11 (ii) An unarmed person participating in an organized fox chase  
12 to chase foxes;

13 (iii) Provided that the provisions of § 10–906(b)(3) of this title are  
14 met, a person:

15 1. Using a regulated shooting ground under § 10–906 of  
16 this title to hunt the following pen-reared game birds:

17 A. Pheasants;

18 B. Bobwhite quail;

19 C. Chukar partridge;

20 D. Hungarian partridge;

21 E. Tower released flighted mallard ducks; and

22 F. Turkey on a regulated shooting ground that was  
23 permitted to release turkey before September 1, 1992; and

24 2. Having the written permission of the owner of the  
25 land or other person designated by the owner of the land, if the land is owned or leased  
26 by a person other than the person hunting on Sundays;

27 (iv) Subject to the provisions of § 10–411 of this subtitle, in  
28 Allegany, Calvert, Caroline, Carroll, Charles, Dorchester, ~~Frederick~~, Garrett, Harford,  
29 Queen Anne's, St. Mary's, Somerset, Talbot, Washington, Wicomico, and Worcester  
30 counties, a person hunting deer on private property with a bow and arrow or crossbow

1 during open season on the last three Sundays in October and the second Sunday in  
2 November;

3 (v) Except on Easter Sunday, in Allegany County and Garrett  
4 County, a person hunting turkey on the last Sunday in April and the first Sunday in  
5 May;

6 (vi) In Calvert County, Caroline County, Charles County,  
7 Dorchester County, and St. Mary's County, a person hunting turkey on private  
8 property on any Sunday during the spring turkey hunting season; and

9 (vii) In Dorchester County, a person hunting turkey on public  
10 land that is designated for hunting by the Department on any Sunday during the  
11 spring turkey hunting season.

12 (3) Subject to the provisions of § 10–415 of this subtitle, in Calvert  
13 County, Caroline County, Charles County, Harford County, Queen Anne's County, St.  
14 Mary's County, Somerset County, and Worcester County, a person may hunt deer on  
15 private property on:

16 (i) The first Sunday of the bow hunting season in November;  
17 and

18 (ii) Each Sunday in the deer firearms season.

19 (4) Provided that the provisions of § 10–415 of this subtitle are met  
20 and subject to paragraph (5) of this subsection, the Department may allow a person to  
21 hunt deer on private property on the first Sunday of:

22 (i) The bow hunting season in November; and

23 (ii) The deer firearms season.

24 (5) The Sunday deer hunting provisions under paragraph (4) of this  
25 subsection do not apply:

26 (i) In Baltimore, Howard, and Prince George's counties; and

27 (ii) In Baltimore City.

28 (6) (i) This paragraph applies only in Carroll County.

29 (ii) Subject to §§ 10–411 and 10–415 of this subtitle, the  
30 Department may allow a person to hunt deer on a Sunday on private property from  
31 the first Sunday in October through the second Sunday in January of the following  
32 year, inclusive.

1                   (7) A person who is 16 years of age or younger may hunt deer with a  
2 firearm on a Sunday through participation in the junior deer hunt established under §  
3 10-405(a) of this subtitle.

4                   (8) (I) THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY IN ~~ALLEGANY~~  
5 ~~COUNTY, FREDERICK COUNTY, GARRETT COUNTY, AND WASHINGTON~~  
6 ~~COUNTY.~~

7                   (II) SUBJECT TO § 10-415 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE  
8 DEPARTMENT MAY ALLOW A PERSON TO HUNT DEER ON A SUNDAY FROM THE  
9 FIRST SUNDAY IN OCTOBER THROUGH THE SECOND SUNDAY IN JANUARY OF  
10 THE FOLLOWING YEAR, INCLUSIVE, ON:

11                                   1. PRIVATE PROPERTY, SUBJECT TO § 10-411 OF  
12 THIS SUBTITLE; AND

13                                   2. PUBLIC LAND THAT IS DESIGNATED FOR SUNDAY  
14 HUNTING BY THE DEPARTMENT.

15                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
16 July 1, 2014.
