<u>Frederick County</u>, Garrett County, and Washington County subject to certain
provisions of law; <u>making conforming changes</u>; and generally relating to the
regulation of deer hunting by the Department of Natural Resources.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
