## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – State’s Attorney – Annual Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the State’s Attorney for Harford County;  
4 providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the salary of  
5 the State’s Attorney for Harford County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
7 Article – Criminal Procedure

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Criminal Procedure**

19 15–413.

20 (a) This section applies only in Harford County.

21 (b) (1) The State’s Attorney’s salary is **[\$98,500]**:

1                           **(I)    \$125,000 FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2014 THROUGH 2016;**  
2 **AND**

3                           **(II)   \$130,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2017 AND EACH**  
4 **SUBSEQUENT CALENDAR YEAR.**

5                   (2)    Subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, on or after July 1 of  
6 each year, the salary shall be adjusted using the annual Consumer Price Index that is  
7 published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics:

8                           (i)    for the period ending each December;

9                           (ii)   for all regions; and

10                           (iii) to reflect the annual change in the “Consumer Price Index”  
11 for “All urban consumers” for the expenditure category “All items not seasonally  
12 adjusted”.

13                   (3)    The annual adjustment under paragraph (2) of this subsection may  
14 not exceed 3% in a fiscal year.

15                   (4)    The county government shall pay all reasonable expenses for the  
16 conduct of the office.

17                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §  
18 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to  
19 the salary or compensation of the State’s Attorney for Harford County while serving in  
20 a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this  
21 Act concerning the salary or compensation of the State’s Attorney for Harford County  
22 shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation  
23 does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act  
24 to fill out an unexpired term.

25                   SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
26 October 1, 2014.
