## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County – Alcoholic Beverages – Organizational Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing an organizational license in Calvert County;  
4 authorizing the license to be issued to a fraternal or civic organization for use on  
5 certain premises; authorizing the licensee to sell beer, wine, and liquor by the  
6 drink for consumption on the licensed premises only; providing for an annual  
7 license fee of \$500; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in  
8 Calvert County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
10 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages  
11 Section 6–301(f)(1)  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (2011 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

14 BY adding to  
15 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

22 6–301.

23 (f) (1) This subsection applies only in Calvert County.

1                   **(4) (I) THERE IS AN ORGANIZATIONAL LICENSE.**

2                               **(II) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED TO A FRATERNAL OR**  
3 **CIVIC ORGANIZATION FOR USE ON THE PREMISES THAT THE ORGANIZATION**  
4 **OWNS OR REGULARLY USES TO HOLD FUNCTIONS.**

5                               **(III) A LICENSEE MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR BY THE**  
6 **DRINK FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES ONLY.**

7                               **(IV) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$500.**

8                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 July 1, 2014.
