# Speech–Language Pathologists – License Renewal Requirements – National Certification

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Examiners for Audiologists, Hearing
Aid Dispensers, and Speech–Language Pathologists to waive certain continuing
education requirements for the purpose of renewing a license to practice
speech–language pathology for a licensee who holds a license to practice
speech–language pathology and a certain national certification that is
determined to be in good standing by the issuing organization; and generally
relating to license renewal requirements for speech–language pathologists.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# Article – Health Occupations

19 2–308.

(a) Except as provided for a limited license in §§ 2-310 through 2-310.3 of
this subtitle, a license expires on the date set by the Board, unless the license is
renewed for an additional term as provided in this section.

(b) At least 2 months before the license expires, the Board shall contact the
licensee by electronic means or first-class mail at the last known electronic or physical
address provided by the licensee and advise the licensee of:
