1 AN ACT concerning

Calvert County - Alcoholic Beverages - Special Event (Festival) Beer, Wine and Liquor <u>License</u> <u>Permit</u>

4 FOR the purpose of establishing in Calvert County a special event (festival) beer, wine $\mathbf{5}$ and liquor (on-sale) license permit; specifying the type of license holder to 6 which the Board of License Commissioners may issue the license permit, subject 7 to certain limitations; requiring an applicant to demonstrate a reasonable 8 expectation of attendance at the special event of at least a certain number of 9 patrons and, if required by the Board, to commit to provide certain additional security personnel; specifying that the license permit authorizes a holder to 10 11 operate additional bars or service counters for the sale and service of alcohol for 12 a certain number of days, subject to the discretion of the Board; specifying a 13license permit fee; authorizing the Board to adopt certain regulations; and 14 generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Calvert County.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

SENATE BILL 548 8-205. THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CALVERT COUNTY. (A) **(B)** THERE IS A SPECIAL EVENT (FESTIVAL) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR (ON-SALE) **LICENSE** PERMIT IN CALVERT COUNTY. **(C)** (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE PERMIT TO A LICENSE HOLDER OF A CLASS B OR CLASS D LICENSE.

8 (2) BEFORE THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS ISSUES 9 THE **LICENSE** PERMIT, THE APPLICANT SHALL:

10 **(I)** DEMONSTRATE A REASONABLE EXPECTATION OF ATTRACTING AT LEAST 500 PATRONS TO THE SPECIAL EVENT; AND 11

12COMMIT TO PROVIDE ANY ADDITIONAL SECURITY **(II)** 13PERSONNEL THAT THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS REQUIRES TO BE 14PRESENT AT THE EVENT FOR TRAFFIC, PARKING, AND PATROL PURPOSES.

SUBJECT TO THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE 15**(**D**)** 16 COMMISSIONERS, THE LICENSE PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO OPERATE ADDITIONAL BARS OR SERVICE COUNTERS FOR THE SALE AND SERVICE OF 1718 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE LICENSED ESTABLISHMENT FOR AT LEAST 1 DAY AND NOT MORE THAN 3 CONSECUTIVE DAYS. 19

20**(E)** THE FEE FOR THE LICENSE <u>PERMIT</u> IS \$500.

21THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS **(F)** MAY ADOPT 22**REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.**

23SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24July 1, 2014.
