Teachers' Retirement and Pension Systems – Reemployment of Retirees – Penalty for Failure to Submit Certification

4 FOR the purpose of altering the amount a local school system or the Maryland School $\mathbf{5}$ for the Deaf must pay as a penalty for failing to submit to the Board of Trustees 6 for the State Retirement and Pension System and the State Department of 7 Education within a certain period of time a certain certification regarding 8 certain retirees of the Teachers' Retirement System or the Teachers' Pension 9 System who are employed by a local school system or the Maryland School for 10 the Deaf and are exempt from a certain retirement allowance offset; 11 generally relating to the penalty for the failure to submit a certain certification 12 regarding certain reemployed retirees in the teachers' retirement and pension 13systems.
