- 3 (A) THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROCLAIM ANNUALLY OCTOBER 2 AS 4 SOUTH ASIAN AMERICAN HERITAGE DAY.
- 5 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE SOUTH ASIAN AMERICAN HERITAGE DAY PROPERLY WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.
- 8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2014.
